## BAMA structure Flanders

### Physical Education & Movement Sciences

#### **1. Academic Bachelor [180]**

Biomedical kinesiology: chemistry, biology, anatomy, physiology, biomechanic

Human kinesiology: sociology, psychology, history, didactics, management...

Movement education & methodology

Research methodology

#### **2. Academic Master of Science [60 → 120]**

**[60]** → specialization + teacher training

**[120]** from '13-'14 → teaching, sports management, training & coaching, health & fitness

#### **3. PhD programme: PhD dissertation**

## Internationalization Wallonia

- Push students to study in foreign Universities (partners)  
Erasmus (Europe) → ECTS: European Credit Transfer and Accumulation System  
Mercator (outside EU)

## Mobility of PE students in UCL

### Criteria for access

Students from UCL, university partners, no fee, min 3 months,  
pass exams in June, education contract with programs (ects)

### Fellowship

Travelling, languages lessons, cost of stay, but not all cost !

### Partnership with 12 universities in PETE (UCL)

France, Spain, Poland, *Czech Republic* , Switzerland, Chile  
Possibility of 26 students out and 23 students in
